This year marks the 50th anniversary of the Rice Bowl Lenten program through Catholic Relief Services. In 1975, CRS Rice Bowl began in Allentown, Pennsylvania as

a response to the devastating drought and famine affecting families in the Sahel region of Africa. "Operation Rice Bowl," as it was known then, was adopted in 1976 under the guidance of CRS in preparation for the 41st International Eucharistic Congress. The bishops in the United States voted for it to be the official program of CRS in 1977.

At this very moment, millions of people are facing life-threatening levels of hunger, food insecurity and malnutrition. At the root of this crisis is a perfect storm of poverty, climate change, conflict and inequality. There is no one solution to breaking the cycle of hunger for every community around the world, but we can do our part by giving alms to CRS Rice Bowl so all may live with dignity.
